- Do not use copyrighted characters, art, logos, etc.

The contest runs from April 1 to April 16 and is open to all. All entries are due by 8 pm on April 16. Return your entry to your local library.

A winner will be selected by the WVLC staff in four age groups: 3-7, 8-12 and 13-18 and adult. Winners will be notified by mail before May 15. The winning bookmarks will be printed and distributed throughout the state. The winners will receive a certificate for themselves and a book prize pack for their local public library.
